

The Associate of Business (AB) degree provides the equivalent of the first two years of a Bachelor's degree in business related subject areas. Students who pursue this degree are primarily interested in transferring to UNLV, UNR or another baccalaureate level institution. A secondary objective may be employment upon completion of the AB.

The following courses may be used to meet the distribution requirements noted on degree sheets. Specific degrees may have additional restrictions. No one course may be used to meet two or more of the distribution requirements. Only courses numbered 100 or above may be used to meet these requirements. Students should make sure that the courses they select will also meet the requirements of the institution to which they intend to transfer.

Students may elect to graduate using the degree requirements in effect at the time of matriculation or completion. If a program is official after a student has matriculated, the student may choose the degree requirements of the new program.
